



<u>Comments & Conclusions:</u> Lane 4 is the test sample He Shou Wu Spagyric Tincture (HSWST101APR23). Lanes 2, 3, 7, 8, are the reference samples used for comparison. This test sample, He Shou Wu Spagyric Tincture (HSWST101APR23) is consistent with the chromatographic profile of the reference samples of *Polygonum multiflorum*, used above. **This test sample He Shou Wu Spagyric Tincture (HSWST101APR23) has characteristics of** *Polygonum multiflorum* **root.**

NOTE: The above conclusion may be a function of the natural variance found in botanicals &/or the extraction process used to create specific extracts. The growing and drying conditions, age, seasonal variations, geographic location, extraction solvents, etc. all play a role in the phytochemical fingerprint of botanicals as well as their extracts; hence, chromatographic variations are expected.
